## APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

### Required

- High School Transcript**
  - Korean/US GED is also acceptable; GED-certified applicants are advised to submit other credentials.
  - Transfer admission applicants are required to submit the academic transcript of the college they attended.
  - Applicants who earned 24 college credits or more are not required to submit a high school transcript.

- Personal Statement**
  - A form is provided in the online application on the SUNY Korea webpage. (Word count limit: 650)
  - Applicants with gap years are recommended to provide relevant explanations.
  - Applicants may submit an optional essay through the application form.

- Letter of Recommendation**
  - Employees of private academies or SUNY Korea faculty/staff are not recommended as a referee.
  - An electronic form will automatically be sent to a referee by email once applicants enter the contact information in the application form.

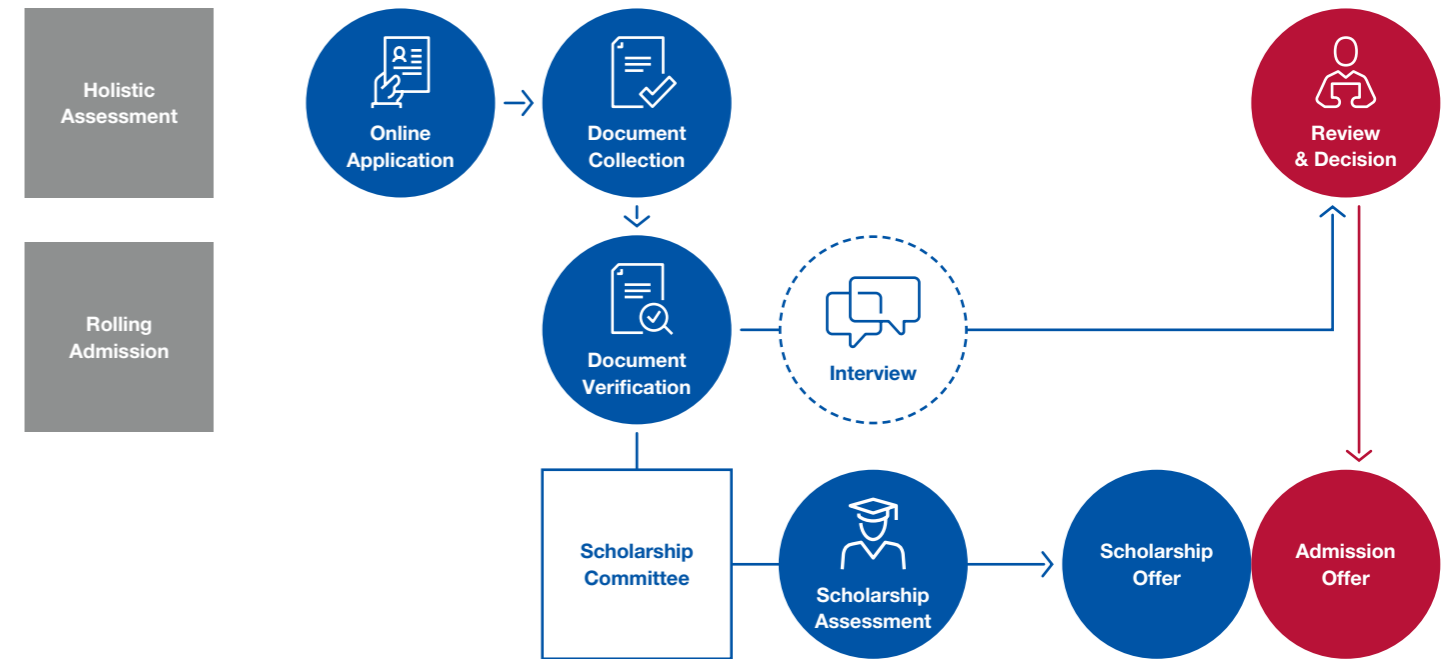
