Fri, Aug. 31	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Last day to waitlist a class. Students are responsible for any tuition liability incurred if registered from a waitlisted class.
Fri, Sep. 7 4:00 pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Last day to process enrollment changes (<u>adds, swaps, credit changes</u>) via <u>SOLAR</u>. Last day to drop or submit <u>LOA/Term Withdrawal</u> without a "W" (withdraw) recorded on transcript. Graduate Students Petition to the Graduate School to process a drop/withdrawal after this date Last day for Winter/Spring degree candidates to apply for graduation.
