Test	Description
RIASEC Holland	This is an interactive version of the IIP RIASEC Markers. Background. The Holland Occupational Themes is a theory of personality that focuses on career and vocational choice. Its groups people on the basis of their suitability for six different categories of occupations.
MBTI	The Myers-Briggs Type Indicator instrument is a questionnaire designed to make psychological types understandable and useful in our everyday lives. MBTI results identify valuable differences between people – differences that can be the source of misunderstanding and miscommunication.
SCT	A test in which the participant must complete an unfinished sentence by filling in the specific missing word or phrase. The test is typically used to evaluate personality. The participant is presented with an introductory phrase to which he or she may respond in any way.
MMPI-2	The MMPI-2 is a self-report inventory with 567 true-false questions about yourself. Your answers help mental health professionals determine whether you have symptoms of a mental illness or personality disorder.
HTP	The house-tree-person test (HTP) is a projective test intended to measure different aspects of personality. Test takers are asked to draw a house, a tree, and a person. The interpretation of these drawings is used to create a picture of the person's cognitive, emotional, and social functioning.
PAI	Personality Assessment Inventory, developed by Leslie Morey, is a self-report 344-item personality test that assesses a respondent's personality and psychopathology.
