※ Test subject under vulnerable environment refers to human research subject whose voluntary decision of participation may be affected by expectation for benefits regarding participation in the research or concerns for disadvantage that he/she may receive from a superior in organization hierarchy when he/she refuses to participate (student, employee of laboratory of medical institutions, employee of company, soldier, etc.), terminal patient, inmate of group institution, unemployed person, poor person, patient under emergency, ethnic minority, vagrant, homeless person, refugee, minor and person who is not able to agree on his/her free will.

8-1. Review can be exempted if the research corresponds to any one of the following.

☐ Research that does not involve invasive action such as drug administration or blood collection

☐ Research using simple touch measuring device or observation device that does not cause physical changes

☐ Research evaluating taste or quality of food permitted for sales according to Article 3 of the enforcement regulation of the Food Sanitation Act

☐ Research investigating texture, satisfaction or the like using cosmetics suited for safety criteria according to Paragraphs 1 and 2 or Article 8 of the Cosmetics Act

8-2. Review can be exempted if the research corresponds to the following.

☐ Human research subject is unspecific, and information collected by the research does not include sensitive information according to Article 23 of Privacy Protection Act

8-3. Review can be exempted if the research corresponds to the following.

☐ Research using information open to general public

8-4. Review can be exempted if the research corresponds to any one of the following. However, for research conducted by the nation or local government directly or through consignment under circumstances requiring urgent action in terms of public health, the progress needs to be notified to the official committee before completing the research.

☐ As research receiving and using human derived materials collected and stored in human derived material bank and genetic information obtained therefrom (hereinafter, "human derived materials, etc."), research that cannot identify personal information unless going through human derived material bank that provides human derived materials, etc.

☐ Research conducting test lab quality management and test method evaluation such as accuracy test using human derived materials, etc. remaining after being used for the purpose of treatment and diagnosis in medical institution

☐ As a case that does not directly collect human derived materials, research using research materials separated and processed from human derived materials (including pathogen, cell line, etc.) so that general public may use

☐ Researcher cannot find out personally identifiable information of human derived material donor, and result obtained from the research is not related to a genetic trait of the donor him/herself (however, research using embryonic stem cell line is not included)
